

## DOCOMO TEAM DANDELION RACING Team Release

## Race Report 2015/10/18 Rd-6 Sportsland SUGO

Weather: Clear Temperature:  $22^{\circ}$ C 19 cars Audience: 6,300/17<sup>th</sup> (Sat.), 12,400/18<sup>th</sup> (Sun)

There are only two races left in 2015 season. So far, Honda users did not stand on the podium except Karthikeyan who won  $3^{rd}$  place in the season opener, and Nojiri who was also in  $3^{rd}$  in Rd 2.

Sportsland SUGO is the circuit where Nojiri successfully won the race as a rookie last year. Here, Honda hopefully will be competitive again.

Nojiri, starting from the third row, got away excellently, but there was no space to pass a car in the narrow SUGO circuit, he just kept 5<sup>th</sup> position. Karthikeyan, who made good starts for the last several races, made a perfect start here and raised 4 positions to finish the opening lap in 12<sup>th</sup>.

Nojiri dove improving his own best lap again and again. However, he began to catch up a-lap-down cars around Lap 20 and lost a lot of time to overtake them. After the middle stage, Nojiri, who was keeping his fast pace, targeted Yamamoto, virtually in 2<sup>nd</sup> position. Monitoring time difference between these two, the team instructed Nojiri to make his pit-stop on Lap 53, the last stage of the race. He went back on-track after refueling only, however, he could not get in front of Yamamoto by a narrow margin. Nojiri continued to push until the end, and by only 0.8 sec, didn't reach for 2<sup>nd</sup>. He finished the race in 3<sup>rd</sup>, the second time on the podium this season.

Karthikeyan, in the group of 6 cars fighting for 8<sup>th</sup> place, kept exerting pressure on others everywhere. After all the exciting laps, he ended up with a 13<sup>th</sup> place.

#40: Tomoki Nojiri Position 3<sup>rd</sup> (2<sup>nd</sup> among HONDA users / recorded fastest lap)

In free practice on Saturday, I felt power to get the pole position, but I was 5<sup>th</sup> in QF actually. If I had grabbed a little higher rank in QF, I could have finished in 2<sup>nd</sup> or more. I took so much time to deal with a-lap-down cars. My car was very good, and I am happy that I recorded the fastest lap, but at the same time, I am feeling I still have issues. I will prepare for the final race at SUZUKA, focusing on the pole position.
