

DOCOMO TEAM DANDELION RACING Team Release

Qualifying Report 2015/11/7 Rd-7 Suzuka Circuit

Weather: Cloudy Temperature: 20°C 19cars

JAF Suzuka Grand Prix is now well known for two races basis which gives us excitement of a start and impression of a finish twice. The starting grid for Race 1 is decided by the orders of knock-out QF1, and then, the starting grid for Race 2 is decided by the result of the final QF after knock-out QF2 and 3.

In knock-out QF1 to decide a place on the grid for Race 1, two cars of DOCOMO TEAM DANDELION RACING went on-track together aiming for the pole position.

They shortened time in Sec1 and Sec2, but couldn't in Sec3. Nojiri was 10th and Karthikeyan was 9th, both moving on to QF2. (However, Car #41 changed the engine because of a trouble during free practice before QF1, Karthikeyan got a penalty of 10 position on the down grid. So, he would start from 18th.)

Following QF2, both of them changed car balance a little, and took off. Nojiri who made one attack with all his might without a mistake finished in 4th position. Karthikeyan regretfully went off the course at Degner Curve and finished in 14th. QF3 is to decide the orders in the starting grid for the top 8 cars.

Nojiri adjusted the set-up predicting change of the course condition, and went on-track early. In Sec1 and Sec2, he showed exceptional speed, however, lost time a little in Sec3. He finished QF in 3rd position.

#40: Tomoki Nojiri Position 10th for Race 1, Position 3rd for Race 2

In QF1, I was afraid that I couldn't reach the top. However, car balance improved as the surface condition got better, and I felt no trouble to be in the top tree. I brought out my best in QF attack, but regarding Sec3, it is obvious that my car had something inferior. I could have pushed harder. There are issues remaining.

#41: Narain Karthikeyan Position 9th for Race 1 (penalty of 10 places down for changing engine, thus starting from 18th) Position 14th for Race 2

Car balance was good from the start, but I felt something was off about the engine. As a result, I had engine trouble caused a penalty of 10 places down on the grid. In QF2, I lost a lot of time because of my mistake, and my position became disappointing. Tomorrow, I will start from behind in both races, but I will fight tenaciously, in my way.
